Monthly Tuition:

30-minute lesson: \$88.00 per month

45-minute lesson: \$132.00 per month

60-minute lesson: \$176.00 per month

Lessons are offered on a month-to-month basis, with no long-term contracts or minimum enrollment requirements. The studio follows a 48-week annual schedule, and monthly tuition remains the same regardless of how many weeks are in a given month. Tuition is due during the first week of each month. Payments may be made by cash or check for in-person transactions, or online through the Opus1 automated payment system.

Opus1:

Opus1 helps our office staff, parents, and students manage communication and billing efficiently. If you choose automatic billing, please refer to the additional letter for step-by-step instructions on setting up your Opus1 account.

Materials Needed:

For your convenience, students may purchase their required music books directly through the studio.

Each student should have a spiral notebook to bring to every lesson for weekly assignments and notes. This notebook serves as an important communication tool between the teacher, students, and parents, and helps ensure that everyone stays informed and accountable for the material covered each week.

Students will also need access to a metronome for daily home practice. There are several free metronome apps available for phones and other devices. If you would like help choosing an app, your teacher will be happy to provide recommendations.



ABC's of Student Expectations:

1. **Arrive** on time – not early, not late
Attendance is necessary to assure progress.

Often, there is another student scheduled before each lesson. Please be considerate and come in at your scheduled lesson time. Please text if you are going to be late.

2. **Bring** ALL needed materials to lesson
3. **Continue** to practice assigned material covered in lesson

Missed Lessons and Cancellation Policy:

If a student is aware in advance that they will be unable to attend a scheduled lesson, please notify the studio office or the teacher as soon as possible. We kindly ask that you avoid scheduling other appointments during your regular lesson time whenever feasible.

In some cases, missed lessons may be rescheduled either in person or online through FaceTime or another video communication platform. Teachers may also provide a recorded video lesson, accessible through the Opus1 platform.

Please ensure consistent communication with your teacher. Credit will not be given for late arrivals or missed lessons without prior notice.

During inclement weather or illness, lessons may be conducted online, using available virtual platforms. Makeup lessons or video alternative may be arranged at any time during the semester, subject to teacher availability. In certain circumstances, group makeup sessions may also be scheduled.

Recitals:

Students present 2 recitals a year – Fall or Christmas and Spring (May or June).

First year student participation is optional.

Recitals are held at Prince of Peace Lutheran Church in Martinsville.

Contests/Competitions:

Students who are unable to enter competitions through their own schools may enter Woodridge Music Academy's Fine Arts Competition held the first Thursday in March, or other contests/festivals held around the state.
